## THEME FOR THE MONTH: WALKING WITH GOD

### MESSAGE: KEYS TO WALKING WITH GOD TODAY BY: PASTOR ANU JULIUS

Six essential keys to help you grow your walk with God, each rooted in scripture:

- 1. Salvation through Faith in Jesus Christ
  - John 14:6 (KJV) Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."
- You cannot walk with God without being born again.
- Jesus is the door to walking with God. Salvation gives you and I access to the Father.
- Without being born again, we are spiritually dead and separated from God.

Romans 5:1 (KJV) Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Philippian jailer in Acts 16. After witnessing the supernatural earthquake and finding Paul and Silas still in their cells, he asked the most important question any person can ask: "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" The answer is: "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved" (Acts 16:31).

The question is: Have we genuinely surrendered to Christ, or we are trying to walk with God in our own strength?

- A Consistent Prayer Life 1 Thessalonians 5:17 (KJV) Pray without ceasing.
- Walking with God requires daily fellowship through prayer.
- Prayer is your lifeline to God

- It's more than asking for things, it's about relationship, intimacy, and listening.
  - Luke 18:1 (KJV) And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint."
- Set aside time to talk with God daily. Include worship, confession, thanksgiving, and requests.

Establish a prayer routine 10-15 minutes daily, gradually increasing, morning and evening. Use the ACTS method:

Adoration (Worship him acknowledging God's greatness),

Confession, Thanksgiving (expressing gratitude for God's goodness),


Supplication (bringing your needs before Him). and ofcus Intercession - praying for others (Matthew 6:9-13)

Jesus regularly withdrew to pray, even when busy (Luke 5:16).

### 3. Meditation and Obedience to God's Word

Joshua 1:8 (KJV) This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night... then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."(2 peyer 1:3)

- The Bible is God's voice in written form.
- To walk with God, we must to listen him, do what He says and apply it to our lives.
- Walking with God means aligning your steps with His Word.

**Psalm 119:105 (KJV)** Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."

- Don't just read the Bible, meditate, memorise, and obey it daily.
- Let words guide every decision, reshape your decisions, values, and speech.

Here's a practical approach to biblical meditation:

- 1. Read a passage slowly and thoughtfully (passive and active)
- 2. Ask what it reveals about God, humanity, and yourself
- 3. Consider how it applies to your current circumstances
- 4. Commit to specific actions based on these insights
- 5. Memorize key verses to carry with you throughout the day

Start with 15 minutes daily in God's Word. Read through entire books rather than isolated verses to understand context. Use tools like concordances and commentaries, but remember that the Holy Spirit is your ultimate teacher (John 14:26).

### 4. Yielding to the Holy Spirit

**Romans 8:14 (KJV)** "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God."

- The Holy Spirit is your daily companion and divine guide,
- The Holy Spirit is not just a feeling; He is your guide, teacher, and comforter. He leads you in your walk with God daily.

**Galatians 5:16 (KJV)** "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh."

Allow Holy Spirit to guide your thoughts, actions, and conversations daily

Begin each day by praying: "Holy Spirit, lead me today. Speak to me, guide me, and help me obey."

When you accepted Christ, the Holy Spirit took up residence within you. Walking with God means allowing this divine Helper to guide your daily life.

John 14:26 the [a] Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

The results of this Spirit-led life are beautiful: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance" (Galatians 5:22-23).

### 5. Fellowship with other Believers

And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together... but exhorting one another..."Hebrews 10:24–25 (KJV)

God didn't design you to walk alone. We are not called to walk alone.

Bible describe the early church in Acts 2:42: "And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers."

God has given us a spiritual family to walk with us, encouraging, correcting, and praying together.

Proverbs 27:17 (KJV) "Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend."

### Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 (KJV)

"Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up."

- God never intended for us to walk with Him in isolation. The Christian life is designed to be lived in community. Your walk is strengthened in community.
- Be actively involved in church. Join a small group. Share your walk with other trusted believers for encouragement and accountability.

Walk with others who are walking with God.

### 6. Obedience and Humility

James 1:22 (KJV) But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."

Walking with God means following His lead, not going your own way.

Obedience often makes no sense:

- Noah building an ark when there was no rain
- Abraham leaving home without knowing the destination
- Joshua marching around Jericho instead of attacking it
- The disciples leaving their nets to follow Jesus

Obedience is the practical expression of our love for God. John 14:15 (KJV) If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Micah 6:8 (KJV) (repeated) walk humbly with thy God."

To walk with God is to say, "Yes, Lord," even when it's hard. even when His direction doesn't make sense.

Obedience shows trust. Humility keeps us dependent on Him, not ourselves, Humility says, "I trust You, Lord.
