## THEME FOR THE MONTH: SUPPLICATION

**Exodus 2:23**

*"During that long period, the king of Egypt died. The Israelites groaned in their slavery and cried out, and their cry for help because of their slavery went up to God." Exodus 2:23 (NIV)*

### When Supplication Becomes a Cry from the Depths

In Exodus 2:23, we saw a moment of profound desperation. The Israelites, bound in slavery and burdened by oppression, groaned, and cried out not with eloquent prayers, but with raw, aching supplication. Their cry was not polished; it was painful. And yet, it reached heaven.

This verse reminds us that supplication is not merely asking it is yearning. It is the soul's cry when words fail, when strength wanes, and when hope seems distant. The Israelites did not have a strategy; they had sorrow. And that was enough for God to respond.

### The Power of a Cry

God did not ignore their groaning. He did not wait for perfect phrasing or ceremonial formality. He heard their cry and remembered His covenant. This is the heart of supplication: a humble, heartfelt plea that moves the heart of God.

In our own lives, we may find ourselves in seasons of silence, where it feels like heaven is quiet and our burdens are loud. But Exodus 2:23 assures us that God hears the cries of His people, even when those cries are soaked in tears and weariness.

### A Call to the Church

This month, let us embrace supplication not as a last resort, but as a sacred invitation. Let our prayers be honest. Let our groans be heard. Let our hearts be laid bare before the One who listens.

Whether you are interceding for healing, deliverance, provision, or peace, remember God responds to the cry of the humble and the righteous. He is not distant. He is attentive. And He is moved by the sound of your supplication.

### Reflection Points

- What burdens have you been carrying silently?
- Have you allowed yourself to cry out to God without reservation?
- How can we, as a church, support one another in seasons of supplication?

May this month be marked by authentic prayer, deep surrender, and divine response. Let our cries rise like incense, and let heaven lean in to listen.
