THEME OF THE MONTH: ASSURANCE

THE ASSURANCE THAT MY REDEEMERS LIVE

Job 19:25

Bible Text: Job 19:25 "For I Know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth".

Introduction

It is human nature to measure our relevance by daily achievements and to assume that God's love is proven only through material blessings, such as a job promotion, a new car, or other visible successes. When such things are absent, we sometimes feel our lives are stagnant or that God is distant.

But in doing so, we often neglect the simple, yet profound blessings of life: the breath we draw each day, the ability to see, walk, move, and enjoy daily provisions, all of which are sustained by God's mercy. These are not random occurrences, but benefits purchased through the price Christ paid. What we consider "basic" or "ordinary" is actually evidence of His ongoing grace.

1. Who is a Redeemer?

To redeem means to exchange one thing of value for another. Biblically, redemption is God's act of delivering humanity from the bondage of sin and death by paying the ultimate price through Jesus Christ, restoring us into freedom and fellowship with Him.

Titus 2:14 gives a clear picture: "Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works."

Redemption required substitution, a sacrifice of great worth. Through the blood and death of Jesus Christ, we were bought back to God, reconciled, and restored as His sons and daughters.

As Colossians 1:13-14 declares, "He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins."

2. Our Conviction of Redemption

It is not enough to know about redemption: we must live with conviction that we are redeemed in Christ. Daniel 11:32b reminds us: "The people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits."

Spiritual maturity is tested not when prayers are answered quickly, but when they are not. Even if healing seems delayed or circumstances remain unchanged, Jesus is still our Redeemer. Our faith must stand firm in trials, knowing that nothing can separate us from His love (Romans 8:38–39).

James 1:12 assures us: "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those

who love Him." True conviction produces steadfastness, a life unshaken by circumstances, anchored in Christ.

3. The Assurance of His Mercy

One of the greatest evidences that our Redeemer lives is the daily assurance of His mercy. Lamentations 3:22-23 declares: "It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning." Every new day, with its protection, provision, and preservation, is proof that God's mercy is at work. Our survival through unseen battles, our children's safety, our health, and the peace we enjoy are testimonies that the Mighty Redeemer is fighting for us.

As Matthew 6:34 reminds us, "Each day has enough trouble of its own." Yet the fact that troubles have not consumed us is evidence of a God who watches over us. He is the Holy One of Israel, the Great Man of War, our Mighty Redeemer! Somebody shout Hallelujah!

4. Conclusion

Finally, brethren, let us be equipped daily with the Word of God. It is our constant reminder of His presence, His promises, and the benefits we enjoy in Christ. For it is written: "Christ in you, the hope of glory." (Colossians 1:27).

Hold fast to this assurance: Our Redeemer lives, and because He lives, we have hope, strength, and
