# INSURING WITH G

"If it had not been the Lord who was on our side... then the waters would have overwhelmed us... Our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth." Psalm 124:1, 8 (KJV)

#### INTRODUCTION

In today's world, we insure almost everything, our cars, homes, health, and even our lives to guard against loss and uncertainty.

But beyond physical protection, we all need divine assurance that only God can provide.

Psalm 124 reminds us that without the Lord on our side, we would have been consumed by life's troubles.

To be "insured with God" means placing our full trust, confidence, and obedience in Him the One who never fails to cover His own.

#### **GOD AS OUR INSURER**

- God is the ultimate Protector, Provider, and Preserver of our lives.
- He watches over us when we are unaware of danger.
- Like an insurer, He guarantees coverage but His coverage is comprehensive and eternal.
- He doesn't just repair losses; He prevents destruction.
- Psalm 91:1–4 "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty."

## **PSALM 121:7–8 "THE LORD SHALL** PRESERVE THEE FROM ALL EVIL..."

Example: David looked back and realised, "If not for the Lord, we would have been swallowed up alive." God had covered Israel from unseen harm.

#### **How Do We Insure Ourselves with God?**

Like every insurance policy, there are terms and commitments. With God, they are spiritual:

- 1. Faith in Christ Accepting Jesus as Lord and Saviour (Romans 10:9–10).
- 2. Obedience to God's Word Staying within His will and commandments (Deuteronomy 28:1–2).
- 3. Prayer and fellowship Maintaining communication with our "divine insurer" (Philippians 4:6–7).
- 4. Trust and surrender Refusing to rely on our own strength or wisdom (Proverbs 3:5–6).
- 5. Walking in righteousness Living under the covering of holiness (Psalm 5:12).

When we do these, we are "signing and maintaining" our spiritual insurance policy with

### What Can Make Us **Uninsured with God?**

Just as earthly insurance can lapse, our spiritual insurance can be broken if we:

- 1. Walk in disobedience and sin Isaiah 59:2: "Your sins have separated you from your God."
- 2. Lack faith and trust Doubt cancels coverage (Hebrews 11:6).
- 3. Neglect prayer and fellowship Failing to communicate with God weakens the relationship.
- 4. Rely on self or man Jeremiah 17:5: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man..."

When we drift away from God's will, we step outside His protective cover.

# **TO STAY COVERED, WE MUST:**

- 1. Abide in Christ daily John 15:4: "Abide in Me and I in you."
- 2. Renew our mind and faith regularly Romans 12:2
- 3. Keep a thankful heart Gratitude keeps our focus on God's faithfulness (1 Thessalonians 5:18).
- 4. Fellowship with other believers Encouragement helps maintain our spiritual strength (Hebrews 10:25).
- 5. Repent quickly when we fall: 1 John 1:9.

God's insurance is renewed every day we choose to walk with Him in truth and humility.

#### **Benefits of Insuring Ourselves with God**

- 1. Divine protection: From dangers seen and unseen (Psalm 91:10–11).
- 2. Peace in the midst of storms: Philippians 4:7.
- 3. Provision and favour: Philippians 4:19.
- 4. Deliverance from evil: Psalm 34:19: "Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivereth him out of them all."
- 5. Eternal security John 10:28: "No one can snatch them out of My hand."


When you are insured with God, you enjoy total coverage for your life, your family, and your eternity.
